Message from Pastor Cyndi:

My friends,

We live in difficult times. Times where division and conflict are common, viral Facebook rants about this or that are common and people pick sides before they have all the information. So it was pleasant and reassuring to gather last night with members of this community and to listen deeply to one another's heart. While the issue concerning whether or not to have flags in the sanctuary is not hotly contentious, it is by working our way through minor conflicts that we build a healthy community, one where diverse points of view are welcome and help us increase our insight and creativity.

We learned a lot last night. We learned that the removal of the flags from the sanctuary was initially due to the need to replace the old, tattered and soiled flags with new ones. We learned that to many it is very important that the flags have a place of respect, whether that is in the sanctuary or not. We learned that the American flag is properly placed to the right of the Christian flag. We learned that the flags carry significant emotional impact for so many of us. We learned that however much we love our country, we want to acknowledge we belong to God first, foremost, and always. We learned that much of the impetus to remove the flags from the sanctuary comes from a desire to ensure that no country, nation, or state ever be allowed to co-opt our faith, which has been done historically from time to time, always to the detriment of the faith.

Mostly, we learned that we really do love and care about one another and that we can have difficult conversations with kindness and care. Holding space for another person to discern their own truth is a truly sacred act. It a practice of inviting people to connect most deeply with their soul and where God is calling them to be. We learned that when our connection with another is broken or dysfunctional for one reason or another, we continue to care for them and feel for them. We learned that we really do have the courage to be deeply vulnerable and that it is safe to do so here.

Our nation, our world, needs this courage, this faithful witness now as much as ever. We must be willing to hear difficult stories, face hard facts, and be gentle with ourselves and others as we do so. We can be, and are, a healing presence through the grace of God.
