Message from Pastor Cyndi:

How Well Do You Love?

We are in the middle of lent, when we are all encouraged to examine our shadow-selves, our hidden, not ready for publication selves. One of the blessings of having a liturgical calendar, of embracing the rhythms of the church year, is being called to this period of self examination every year, because for most of us, it's not something we enjoy doing. I know it's something I tend to put off until someone, or something, calls me to account. I know that when I take up some courage and look at all the parts of myself I want to hide, and I'm really honest about what I can change, what is mine, what belongs to someone else, I feel better and I act better afterwards. I know that when I look at all the things I wish were different and own up to how much of it is me, I'm empowered and can act to change those things.

Still, there is a temptation during lent and during all of the seasons of our life which are hidden and full of shadows, full of fear, loss, and grief, to turn inwards and stay inwardly facing. We can get stuck there. Being able and willing to turn inwards and examine oneself, and still keep one's heart and focus on the broader world is a matter of balance. God calls us not to the endless task of self-improvement but to love and care for our neighbor, for all of God's children across the world, and that includes us. If we are to examine ourselves and see where we are lacking, perhaps the most significant question we might ask is, how well do I love? How well do I love the stranger, the different, the weird, the unsociable, the loud, the quiet, the traditionalists, the innovators! How well do I love, especially when it's hard.

It fills my heart to know that at First Presbyterian we are committed to being a church that takes spiritual growth seriously and that is actively engaged in mission to the whole world. We are committed to crossing boundaries, to loving across differences of culture, socio-economic status, language barriers, and anything else that would seek to divide us. We are committed to inviting people of all persuasions to meet Christ and to find where God is active in their lives. Our world feels more divisive than ever, but here at First Presbyterian we are more and more committed to living and loving like Jesus!

So yes, we pause in this season of lent for reflection and self-examination, and we continue this inward turning move until we are again facing all those around us ready to love more fully. Our lenten journey prepares us to return refreshed and renewed, with new energy and new enthusiasm. We walk this path knowing it will change us, transform us, and remake us. We walk this path knowing we may be broken by what we experience and that God can work in us and through us right through the brokenness. We walk this path that we might be drawn closer to God and closer to our neighbor as we are pulled into God's mission for the world.

Scrip is a lifestyle fundraiser. Families see how easy it is to earn just by purchasing a **gift card**, so after placing their first few orders, shopping with scrip becomes a habit. They're continually motivated to shop with scrip because they can immediately see how much money they're raising. If you need a little more convincing, we came up with the top 5 reasons why scrip is the better fundraising solution for both your organization and your families.

WHY SCRIP IS BETTER FOR ORGANIZATIONS

1. You're not spending time and energy trying to organize a fundraiser and **sell overpriced products**.
2. Scrip isn't **burdensome**. You aren't asking families to go out of their way to raise money. Instead, their everyday family purchases become immediate earnings for your organization.

They also have something called Presto Pay that allows the money to be pulled directly from your checking account so no running around to collect or do banking is necessary. This costs the individual 15 cents per order and is only pulled once a week (see online info for more details). This is very handy for those who use the smart phones because you can order and have it pull up on your phone (no printing or waiting needed).

I also wanted to challenge each family to find at least one expense that they are already doing and use the scrip gift cards for it. For example, if you use Costco or Woodmans for groceries (two of the few places that scrip does not have cards for) then you can use your gas expense with the numerous gas stations (example: Kwik Trip). What about gift cards for gifts (birthday, holidays, special occasions) through the scrip program? Weather shopping online or traveling, there should be something that every family can find with their expenses that is located in the 700 cards available through the scrip program. If we all use it, then God can use our rebate funds to do amazing things! If God can do great things with a mustard seed, think of what he could do with the funds made in the scrip program!
