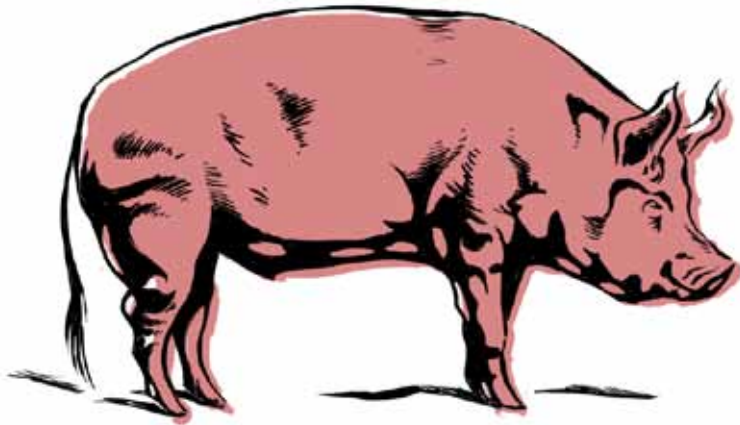
COFFEE HOUR VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!
