#### Message from Pastor Cyndi:

There is something about the fall that seems to lend itself to deep contemplation. Perhaps it is the longer nights, the cooler weather encouraging more time huddled by the fireplace, but whatever it is, I am so very grateful for it. It feels to me like a time of preparation, a sort of advent for the new year and whatever resolutions or discernment I need to make.

We live in a world where decisions tend to overrun discernment but there is great beauty in a discernment process. It opens us up to the work of the Holy Spirit, or at least it's intended to. The decision making process is quick and analytical. It is a very left-brain, logical process. The discernment process is much more open ended, imaginative, invitational, and to me, exciting. It opens us up to awe and wonder as we contemplate where God is at work in our lives, in our community, in our church.

It invites us to review where we are in our spiritual growth, this never-ending process of coming closer to God, to being remade and re-created by God. This year I am engaged in a really wonderful confirmation class with two great kids who have engaged deeply and it's stirred something in me. Perhaps it is time to write a confession again, to deconstruct all that I thought I knew and from those elements to carefully reconstruct a faith statement that is clearer, brighter, more true for me today. This process of seeing where one has grown, how the Spirit is moving in one's life, is terribly exciting to me. I hope that, as you engage with worship, with Christian ed, with bible study, with your own personal spiritual practice, that you too are experiencing the work of God within yourself. The exciting and soul-trembling piece of this is realizing that God is always at work within us, always drawing us closer, and always waiting for us to say 'Yes' to this process.

So I am heading into the new year with much anticipation and excitement about where God is leading us, and who God is transforming us into. I have done several continuing education programs that focus solely on the pastor as one who will go out, learn great things, and through dint of effort and charisma, bring everything back to the church, creating growth and transformation. I must admit that doing this work solely on my own has been frustrating. This year, I want to invite all of you to join me on the path of learning, of discerning, of opening ourselves up to where God is leading us. This year, I want the whole church to join me in this transformative spiritual growth. God does not want only me to come closer or be more holy, but wants all of us to draw near, to embrace the path that God lays out for us, to enter a period of discernment and deep listening for where God is taking us.

Therefore, your session and I have discussed doing a congregation wide book study of Neighborhood Church: Transforming Your Congregation Into a Powerhouse for Mission. This book talks about the ways many churches have experienced God's transformative work in their midst, drawing them closer to God and to their community. We know that God is doing something new in the Church today, and we want to be one of those churches which are engaging in this process.

I hope that you will join me and your session in engaging all of this. God is very much with us, and continues to do great things in our midst.

#### STEWARDSHIP AND FINANCIAL PLANNING

The year has flown by and unbelievably, the holidays and the year 2020 are just around the corner. Where has this year gone? The Finance Committee is beginning the

process of supporting the financial needs of our Church. As we are in the midst of Stewardship, budgeting and financial planning, we thought it might be helpful to suggest a new giving strategy and plan for our donations.

A change in the tax laws has for many of us effectively taken away the charitable deduction which was claimed on Schedule A. However. there is another avenue that can produce tax savings. For those individuals over age 70 1/2 who are taking payments from their IRA, there is another method of donation. As you may know, the IRS requires a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) each year. This amount varies from person to person. The IRS now allows a direct charitable donation from the custodian (bank, brokerage, etc.) to the charity, in our case Lodi Presbyterian Church. There is a substantial monetary advantage to both you and the Church.

Combining the federal and state income tax rates reveals the tax savings. Let's assume that your combined federal and state tax rates are 20% to 25% or more. If you make your donation from your after tax income, you are paying tax on your donation. By making a direct donation it would not taxed. In fact, a pledge could be increased by 10% or

15% and you would still have more money than by making your donation in after tax dollars.

Although it may seem a different way to donate, it is absolutely legal. You would simply have to direct the custodian of your IRA to make the donation directly to the Church, not to you. It may be made at any time during the year not just on January 1st

You may wish to talk to your accountant, tax advisor or other tax professional about using this donation method. There is also a specific way it must be handled on your tax forms. This information should be shared with your tax preparer.
