My friends,

We are beginning this year as a year of deep listening and discernment. In order to see the way forward we must embrace and engage with a culture that has shifted dramatically over the course of our life times and which continues to change. We are now living in a culture that can and does shift overnight, leaving our institutions struggling to keep up and respond faithfully. Gil Rendle, a pastor and church consultant for more than 25 years, tells us that, "The more anxious the peope are in our changed liquid reality, the more they look to leaders for clear, simple, linear solutions that reduce anxiety even when they don't help move to the future. However, complexity and unpredictable interactions that continue to defy linear planning or clear solutions are increasingly the conditions of a liquid culture. We continue to move farther away from our linear, predictable, controllable past." Gil is reminding us that often what we think of as a problem with a simple, straight forward solution, is actually a new condition of life. It's just the way it is, and we must change. We can't fix it like we can a broken pipe or a downed fence. Instead we must learn a new way to thrive in what actually is the way things are. Which reminds me that someone once told me that being a pastor is about disappointing people gently, a little at a time.

The work of your session and myself is not to try to manage the church as if our culture were still in that slow, steadfast, predictable stage. It is to embrace the people and the times in which we find ourselves immersed, and this means refusing to simply manage the business of the church. We must become leaders, discerning the path forward with courage and conviction. We must take healthy risks, nurture them, support them and then evaluate what has taken root and what has not.

There are three stumbling blocks on this path that we must keep an eye on.

- 1) We must not allow our habitual ways of seeing things to keep us from seeing the new thing that God is doing. We must remain curious and open to learning new things, to seeing things in a new light.
- 2) We must not allow cynicism or despair to tell us that our efforts are futile and nothing will make any difference, nor will this effort produce any fruit. We must instead embrace compassion and empathy for all the people and the new efforts they are making.
- 3) We must not allow fear to freeze us or make us defensive. We must be courageous, whole hearted, and take risks. We must allow ourselves to be vulnerable to the world we find ourselves in and let our armoured way of being go. Being defensive will not help us be faithful.

My friends, it is true that I am making an assumption that you all want this church to thrive and continue to witness to the Gospel for another 150 years. I am assuming that you are willing to dig deep and work through change even when it feels weird and does not meet your assumptions and expectations. I believe that all of you wish to follow Jesus and that when you hear that call, "leave your nets and traditional way of being. Come and follow me. I will change your life," your answer will be Yes.
