



THE PASTOR'S CORNER

As I write these musings for October, I have yet to leave for, much less return from, our tour of Celtic highlights in the United Kingdom (September 20-October 3). To avoid writing something for this space that would seem outdated or premature by the time you read it, I shall offer a meditation on something timeless: Psalm 139.

- ➤ Whether tongue-tied or suffering from writer's block, I am grateful for God's reassuring word in 139:4: "Before a word is on my tongue, You, Lord, know it completely." This truth applies to the sermons I must write before I leave,... to the words of condolence I offer to the family who just lost a loved one,... and to the prayers I offer to God for all of you in the weeks we are apart.
- ▶ Being "apart" must be amended by God's truth in 139:9-10: "If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there Your hand will guide me, Your right hand will hold me fast." Yes, across the pond, God will guide Sue and me in our tour decisions. Psalm 139 also reassures us that, this side of the Atlantic, God also guides and provides for you. Thanks be to God that we're vitally connected and intimately cared for. Your comforting presence and connection were evident during FPC's hosting of Bonita Prucha's funeral service on September 13. Also, I trust "God is with us" when Mitch preaches, the Elders lead, and Zoe covers the office in my absence.
- This update is for those who saw me limping in worship due to a non-contact injury to my right knee while playing racquetball. The results of the MRI were encouraging, once again proving the truth of 139:14-15: "I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful." I pray that these reassuring words, about how we are made and remade whole, apply to all who have shared health concerns in recent weeks.

Indeed, when one part suffers, we all suffer, and when one part rejoices, we all rejoice. To that end, I thank God for our new hire, Zoe, who keeps us connected and informed in ways beyond bulletins and newsletters. Herein, you'll see recaps of Elder, Deacon, Finance & other team meetings. A few updates from your leadership teams who are equipping and serving you:

➤ On October 5, we kick off a "Sunday School class" discussion of *Holy Disruption*. To be held during the 2nd hour post-worship on Sunday, at a table or two in the back of Fellowship Hall. The books have arrived. Pick up yours so you can read up.

> Starfish Campaign. From the Generosity Task Force of JKP, this campaign effectively retires medical debt by triggering a 100-fold

match. This campaign is month-long and will end October 19 (make checks payable to FPC-Lodi and include "starfish" in the memo).

➤ **Gideon's ministry.** Our neighbor, Paul Knutson, will present this ministry on **October 26**, and a free-will offering will be taken that day for the Gideons.

Lunch Buddies:




